

Call for Artists ~ Invitation to Show

The Waimea Arts Council invites Hawaii Island artists to join and enter the

37th ANNUAL FOUNDERS JURIED ART SHOW

Firehouse Gallery • October 1 – November 28, 2021

~ PROSPECTUS ~

WHO: This juried art show is open to current and new members (October 2021- September 2022) of the Waimea Arts Council. Basic membership (\$35 annually) is open to all adults 18 and older. All media will be accepted: Cash awards announced Oct. 1, 2021.

ENTRIES: Entry fee is \$15 per entry. You may enter three pieces. Entry fees are non-refundable. All entered pieces must be available for sale. Works must be original (no prints or reproductions will be accepted, with the exception of photographs), have been completed in the last two years and have not been accepted in past Waimea Arts Council sponsored juried shows or have won previous awards in any contest.

The maximum size for any entry, including frame is 36" x 36" (or an equivalent of 1296 square inches). Artwork must be ready for installation - including suitable frames with wires (no saw tooth hangers or shrink wrap), bases and/or mounts as required. All exhibitors are asked to volunteer to keep the gallery open during the show. If you volunteer during this show, a 30% donation/commission to the Waimea Arts Council (501(c)3 nonprofit organization) should be factored into your sale price – 50% for members who do not volunteer at the Firehouse Gallery during the exhibition dates: 10/1 – 11/28, Friday, Saturday and Sunday 11 am – 3 pm.

JUDGING: This is a juried show, and the juror has discretion to choose which entries will be included in the exhibit. Entry fees will not be refunded if piece is not chosen for exhibit. Entries will be judged using five criteria: originality, visual balance, visual clarity, personal expression and execution of the medium. Cash award amounts will depend on the number of entries.

This year's invited judges are Johanna Wiseman and Shirley Spencer, local artists and the proprietors of Akamai Art Supply in Kona, who hold a finger on the Big Island's art scene.

ENTRY DATE: Works must be submitted at the Firehouse Gallery, 67-1201 Mamalahoa Hwy., between the hours of 11 am to 3 pm on Friday & Saturday, September 24 & 25. Those artists whose pieces are not chosen for exhibition will be contacted to pick the artwork up. Exhibiting artists are asked to volunteer to keep the gallery open for four hours during gallery hours. (Gallery hours: 11 am – 3 pm Friday through Sunday).

RECEPTION: No public reception will be held due to COVID-19.

PICK UP DATE: Those works selected will be on display for viewing and purchase in the Firehouse Gallery October 1 – November 28, 2021. You may pick up your pieces in the afternoon of November 28. Pieces left after 30 days will be considered abandoned and may become the property of WAC and considered as a donation.

The Waimea Arts Council will handle all work with the utmost of care; however, artists will be responsible for liability of individual art and will hold the Waimea Arts Council and the County of Hawaii harmless. WAC reserves the right to cancel the show if there are not enough entries.

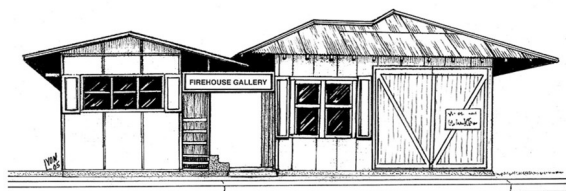

**General Guidelines and Waiver for
Members Exhibiting in the Firehouse
Gallery Programs**

In submitting work for display at the Waimea Arts Council's (WAC) Firehouse Gallery, I agree to the following conditions:

- The Gallery Committee has the right to choose work for display based on appropriateness of content, presentation, and space available. No nudes may be exhibited in the gallery.
- Art must be delivered to the gallery at the times/date specified and picked up by the artist no later than one week following the close of the exhibit. Work left at the gallery after that time will become the property of WAC and will be disposed of at the discretion of the WAC Board, unless special arrangements are made with the Gallery Chair.
- I understand that WAC is not responsible for paying General Excise Tax on artwork sold for the artist at the Firehouse Gallery. It is my responsibility to hold a GET license, to keep track of my sales, and to submit the tax as required by state law.

WAIVER

All artwork delivered to the Firehouse Gallery will be handled with the utmost of care. However, the Waimea Arts Council will not be held responsible for damage, theft, or loss of work exhibited. Each artist is responsible for obtaining their own personal insurance if they choose to cover artwork and or any other item left at the gallery. This includes events held outside of the gallery and under the auspices of the Waimea Arts Council.

I understand the terms of exhibiting and agree to be responsible for the liability of my personal property. I understand WAC does not insure items for loss. I also agree to indemnify and hold harmless the Waimea Arts Council, its employees and volunteers, and the County of Hawaii from any and all claims relating to damage or loss of my property in or about the Waimea Arts Center, and from any court costs and attorney fees relating thereto.
